



BCHS Re-Opening “at a glance” for In-Person Learning



Before School	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Self Screening at home• If temperature is 100.4 or higher, student will need to stay home
Transportation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Temperature will be taken prior to boarding bus• Masks/face coverings must be worn• Assigned seats to aid with contact tracing
Arrival	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Multiple entrances will be utilized to distance students. (Assigned entrances will be given to car-riders, drivers and bus riders)• Doors will open at 7:00am.• Students arriving from 7:00am-7:15am will check in at attendance office entrance and report to the gym until time to report to first period. (9th grade students will report to Trojan Academy).• 21st Century Program will offer extended school day services prior to 7:00am. Enrollment will be required through 21st Century.• Temperature checks and screening will be done at entry for all students and staff.• Car-riders will have temperatures taken before exiting the vehicle.• Buses will unload one at a time and students will be directed to multiple entrances for “in-processing”.• If temperature exceeds 100.4, student will be escorted to a holding area for parent pickup.• Masks/face coverings must be worn.• Students will report directly to the first period teacher instead of common areas.

Breakfast	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Breakfast will be served in classrooms just before 1st period. There will not be a breakfast break later in the morning.
Classroom Instruction & Class Changes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● A modified block class schedule will be implemented, but with staggered class changes by sector to reduce numbers in hallways.● Students will attend fewer classes daily to minimize transitions.● Year long “skinny” classes will meet as blocks on alternating days to reduce transitions.● Students WILL get to take elective & career pathway courses.● Masks must be worn when 6 ft distancing is not possible, or when moving.● Students will use hand sanitizer upon entry to each classroom.● Students may not gather in groups during class transitions.● Vending machines will be turned off due to health guidelines.● Desks/surfaces will be cleaned between groups of students during class changes.● Lockers will not be used. Backpacks are permitted.● Bathroom breaks will be scheduled during class time instead of during transitions between class.
Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Students will eat in classrooms.● Lunches will be delivered and all meals pre-packaged.● Students may bring their own lunch.
Extra-Curricular	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● No field trips or assemblies will be planned until health guidelines allow for this.● Sports will follow KHSAA guidelines.● Music programs will follow KMEA recommendations.● Club meetings will be offered in a virtual format after school hours.

Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will be dismissed by bus number from their last period class instead of a mass dismissal to bus circle.• Car riders and drivers will be dismissed in groups with staggered dismissal times.
Distance Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All teachers will be using Google Classroom for in-person instruction. In the event of a student absence or school closure, instruction will be provided via Google Classroom.
