



BCCHS Re-Opening Plan & Learning Options

Option 1: In-Person, Traditional Classroom Experience

With Option #1, students attend school, following the Governor's #HealthyAtSchool safety expectations/ guidelines: (Click link to review guidelines) - [Barren County Schools Healthy at School Summary](#)

- Social Distancing- This means staying 6 feet apart in school when possible.
- Cloth Face Coverings- Students and staff will wear masks/face coverings when social distancing of 6ft or more is not possible.
- Screening and School Absence - includes daily temperature checks for all students and staff and staying home from school if you are sick.
- Sanitation- includes proper hand hygiene, frequent cleaning and disinfecting of all surfaces, buildings and school buses.
- Students may switch to all virtual learning for extended closures due to COVID-19- Students who attend school in person may be asked to learn at home, with help from their teacher, for a period of time if there is an increase in COVID-19 cases in our community.

Our main goal is to have students in our buildings, but we realize that ***it may be necessary to create alternate scheduling plans***, depending on COVID-19. (Example: Meeting in fewer classes per day to limit transitions and to assist with contact tracing, eating in classrooms to limit group sizes, etc.)

OPTION #2: Distance Learning Provided by School (9-12)

Students may OPT TO SIGN UP for a distance learning option to complete courses via Edgenuity from home anticipating a transition back to school when conditions improve.

- Commitment required by signing agreement with the school for **at least ONE SEMESTER** (9-12).
- Students would have **a set schedule** & access curriculum via Edgenuity.
- Household should have internet access for students to utilize virtual learning.
Some school devices would be available for student use, if needed.

At home learning with BCHS teachers facilitating learning.

SIGN UP PERIOD: July 13th-24th — Homes must have internet service and technology access in order to participate in this new program. Student work and progress will be consistently monitored by BCHS teachers and staff for successful progress/completion of coursework and students will still be enrolled with Barren County Schools.

OPTION #3: Fully Online (6-12) provided by BAVEL

Students APPLY and INTERVIEW for full-time ONLINE classes with Barren Academy of Virtual and Expanded Learning (BAVEL) (a separate BARREN COUNTY school). More information at [this link](#).

- Commitment is for ONE FULL YEAR, if you are accepted.
- Household must have internet for students to access virtual learning.

At home learning and with BAVEL teachers from across the state.
